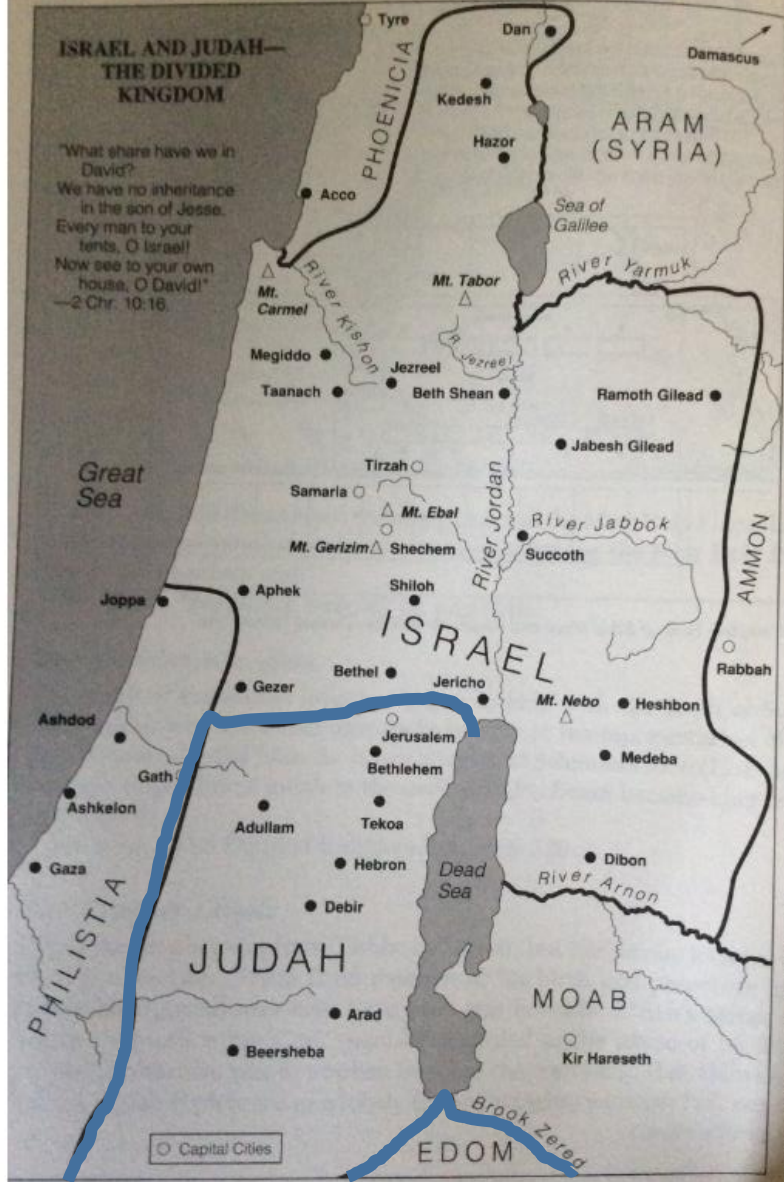

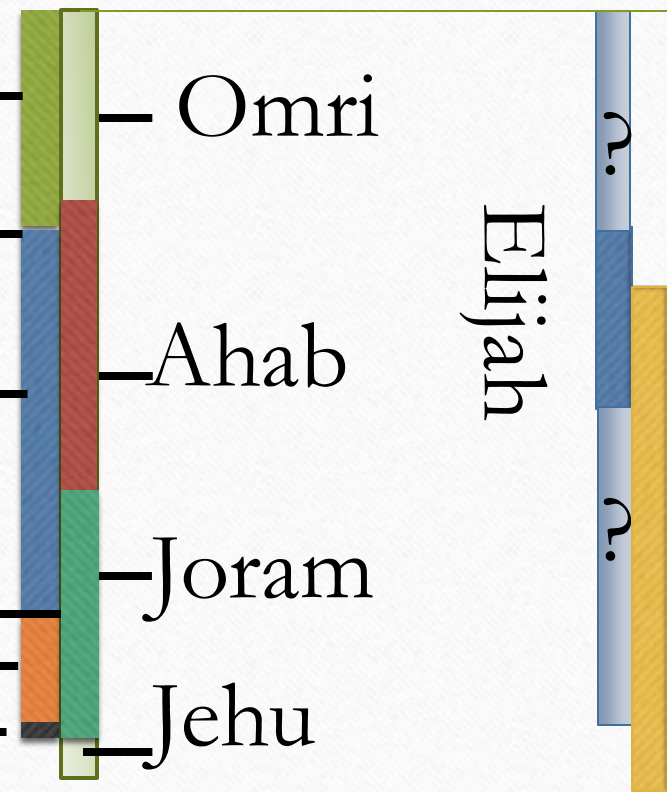

- Did not remove the high places (I Kings 22:43)
- Allied with Israel, “Made Peace with Israel” (I Kings 22:44)
